

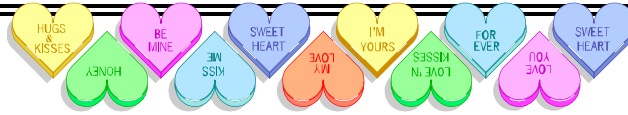

## Baseball 2011

As with last year, all baseball registration will be handled online by National Headquarters.



There are no exceptions to this. If you do not register at the National designated website, your team cannot play American Legion Baseball. This is also true for the SA Vandyk insurance. Proof of insurance must still be submitted to the Department. Any team who fails to purchase insurance from S.A. VANDYKE shall be disqualified. **Any new team must submit a forfeit fee to Department Headquarters, \$100 for Jr, \$200 for Sr.** All teams must have insurance purchased from S.A. VANDYKE. Fees for Sr will be \$200 Department fee and \$50 National fee. Jr will be \$100 Department fee and \$25 National fee. If anyone is interested in starting a new team, please call Department Headquarters for online registration information, and State Chairman Roy Waters at 828-294-1263 for league information.

## Membership Messages

During the past several months, Membership Cards have been received at Headquarters with numerous changes such as a name change and change of address written on the Membership Cards instead of on a plain sheet of paper. Please do not make these changes on the Membership Cards. You can now send them on a piece of paper, by email or by going to National's website and doing it yourself. Please refer to your Post Adjutants Manual, page 15 for information on your Post Membership Cards and information on the Member Data Form. Also, if someone transfers into your Post, **Please** do not forget to include a Membership Data Form. Transfers cannot be made by simply checking the block on the renewal card. Be sure to fill in all information including address and phone number on the MDF. This is especially important if it is a 1981 member. If the member has already paid for this year

before the transfer, do not send a renewal card. Remember, no money, no card.

When you submit a Paid-Up-For-Life application, make the check payable to National Headquarters, American Legion for the amount of the PUFL only. These checks should be kept separate from regular membership payments as we forward PUFL payments directly to National for processing. Remember to sign the officer signature line and have your member sign the applicant line. If you have any questions, please telephone Rose at Department Headquarters. The **new PUFL application** requires an attached copy of one of the three following items; DD214, military ID or driver's license. Remember, the new application is the only one now accepted.

## Reminder for District/Division Candidates

Anyone planning to run for District, Division or Department Office will need to get your endorsement and picture to Department Headquarters by **February 10, 2011** to be included in the March/April NC Legion News. The next issue after that will be a deadline of **April 10, 2011** for the May/June issue. **These materials will be used for a "one time only" courtesy announcement.**

Please be sure that your post has and is filing the required 990 Tax form. **If not filed, Your Post Tax Exempt status is in jeopardy.** This is not an option, this is a requirement. The longer you wait, the worse the situation becomes. Do not hesitate or put off any longer. Check your post records and be sure you are filing a Form 990 each and every year and it does not matter how big or how small your post is. Please do it today!!!!
