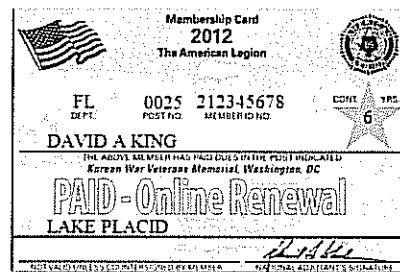

On-Line Membership Renewal

Beginning July 1, 2011, all Legion members can renew their 2012 membership on-line through www.legion.org/renew.

Members renew using a credit card, print a temporary card and mail or take their receipt to the post to receive their new card.



Posts will continue to have all cards sent with their roster.

Notification of on-line renewals can be obtained directly from the www.mylegion.org post officer's site. Notification will also be provided by reports sent by their department headquarters. Posts will receive their per capita as determined by their department headquarters. Contact your department with any questions regarding post per capita disbursement.

- ✦ Find members in your area of expired members and eligible DMS members using a radius search and generate reports to contact them
- ✦ Generate reports of current, expired, deceased and undeliverable members
- ✦ Submit Annual Consolidated Post Report
- ✦ Download Membership Materials, Brochures and Suggested Speeches
- ✦ Communicate with other officers through MyLegion Officer's Forum
- ✦ View electronic Dispatch
